Rules

- Tepee must be set up using 15 poles
- Tepee rips or pole breakage will be disqualification
- Overall appearance is judged for neatness and adherence to Shoshone or Comanche style (20 possible points)
- Total combined score will determine winners
- Timed event:
 - Fastest team (30 points)
 - 2nd Fastest team (20 points)
 - 3rd Fastest team (10 points)
